SEWER PERMITS

Sewer Tap Permit

A permit to tap the mainline at the street and bring sewer service to the lot at the property line. Construction on the lot is not yet planned.

Sewer Connection Permit

A permit to connect the service line to the mainline and to the structure. Building permit has been issued or applied for from City or County.

Road Cut Permit


A road cut permit may be required prior to connecting to the sewer main.

- All permit applications are available by request at the administration office.
- Permit and Inspection Fees must be paid to process the Sewer Tap application.
- System Development Charges and Permit and Inspection Fees must be paid at time o process the Sewer Connection Permit application.

NBWA Inspections are required for:

Service line connections between the main sewer and the property line.

Connection of the house sewer lateral to the sewer stub at the property line.



Contractors tapping a sewer main are required to submit their Certificate of Liability Insurance

Connection must be completed within six months of Sewer Connection Permit issue date.

Copies of As-Built Maps showing the sewer main locations and depths are available at the administration office.

NBWA Field Operators are available to assist in the location of manholes, clean-outs, and sewer stubs.

Information for Developers and Contractors

Contact the NBWA Administrative office prior to development of any sewer extension or subdivision.

Check List:

- 1. Contact NBWA for planning information
- 2. Submit preliminary plans to DEQ and NBWA for approval
- After approval, obtain Sewer Permit from NBWA office and notify NBWA 24 hours prior beginning construction
- 4. Engineer send Certificate of Completion with testing results to DEQ and copy to NBWA.
- 5. Sign & Record easements at the County, send originals to NBWA.
- Submit a digital copy or CD of Auto CAD to NBWA.
- 7. Pay all fees in full, submit one-year warranty on project to NBWA

NBWA Inspectors will review the work progress and can perform the required air & vacuum testing. Billing for NBWA inspections will be monthly and based on time spent.
