MANAGER'S REPORT

River Levee Maintenance: We received approval from the Army Corp of Engineers to move forward with the levee project. The County has put the project out for public comment, starting February 4th and ending February 22nd. If all goes well, we can submit that plan to DSL and include the County's signature for the land use form and the waterway structure. The work can begin in July 2022 once the application is approved.

River Gauge: We have not heard anything different about the installation dates of February 14th-18th. It will be nice to start gathering data before the new permit application gets approved

The Next Big Project: We are taking a year off from dredging the biosolids out of A-cell. We have ½ of A-cell to complete. Doing it this Summer would have increased the amount of nitrogen added to the fields and that isn't good for the fields or for DEQ. We will have Matt Marti do his normal routine for this year and we will finish dredging A-cell in 2023. We are planning to upgrade Wheeler North Pump Station after July 1st. This will include new Flygt pumps, new controls, and a new force main. We will keep the old force main in place for the redundancy that DEQ likes so much. We will be meeting with Kennedy Jenks to go over the project and get a cost proposal. We already have the new pumps and a step transformer. Most of the engineering costs will be in the boring of a new force main.
